

## Ethics Principles

It is important to us to give people a space in which they have enough freedom to look at the topics differently and to come up with the best solution through discussion and collaborative work. We do not exclude anyone, because it is only through different perspectives that we will be able to understand the different points of view and to dispel fears or prejudices.

The following values are important to us:

- The members of our Society take sustainability and responsibility seriously and are ready to make their contribution to a life-affirming and positive development.
- The members of our Society are willing to make compromises and work to bring together economic interests and the environment, taking into account the global and local conditions, **and see no contradiction in this.**
- The members of our Cooperative are committed to free, informal discussion, but also acknowledge new jointly gained insights.
- The members take the fears of others seriously and work to dispel them.
- The members tolerate the opinion of the other, withdrawing their egos as much as possible.
- Personal wishes and goals are emphasized by the individual in the discussion, but should ultimately subordinate themselves to the common good to be recognized under the common good.
- The members are tolerant of existing political conditions, attitudes to life and actions. We regard everything that still exists today in human life as well as in the changes of nature as a given fact, which has resulted from positive and negative developments of the past. We see this as the relative situation, which is our starting point to analyze new developments in the discourse with people in order to initiate necessary changes.
- The members are committed to global peace, recognize every life in the most diverse countries with their most diverse cultures and promote education in all areas.
- The members are committed to a cultivated culture of debate, both in national and international discourse.
- Each member feels obliged, according to its possibilities, to open up in its opinions and to participate in the findings from it in order to bring about positive changes of any kind in its immediate environment.
- Each member rethinks its own behavior as well as its attitudes to life and should be a role model for the neighbor.
